The Standard Mental Health First Aid Refresher course is based on the international MHFA Guidelines. These guidelines developed through the expert consensus of people with lived experience of mental health problems, carers and professionals.

Who can attend a MHFA Refresher course?

This refresher course allows people who have completed a 12-hour Standard Mental Health First Aid (MHFA) course to update their knowledge and skills.
